The Chicago Bulls joined the NBA in 1966 and struggled for the better part of a quarter century. That all changed in the mid-1980s with the drafting of Michael Jordan, the dominant player of his era and possibly the greatest player of all time. In the early 1990s, Jordan led the Bulls to three consecutive NBA titles, followed by three more in the late 1990s, giving the Bulls six NBA championship trophies. www.nba.com/bulls
